Canadian Association of Blue Cross Plans (CABCP) is an association of five independent not-for-profit Blue Cross organizations that provide health, disability, travel and life insurance to more than 7 million Canadians. All member plans operate independently and are governed by their own Board of Directors.

IMPORTANT: Blue Cross organizations cover members who live, work and play in all provinces and territories in Canada. It is therefore important to confirm a member’s ID card to ensure that you register and submit to the correct Blue Cross organization.

Blue Cross organizations also partner with various government organizations to administer health, disability and/or travel benefits.
